GEP Exposure English/Math & GA Camp (P3 in 2019)

Learning Objectives:

Prepares children for optimal performance in the 2019 P3 GEP 2nd round of selection. This camp will expose students to complex Math and English components to develop their critical thinking skills in non-routine & GA questions.

Overview of the topics:

Classification skills, sequencing, spatial reasoning, logic, analogies, abstract visual reasoning and mathematical reasoning

Keywords Science Camp (P4/P5)

Learning Objectives:

This programme helps students to build up process and analytical skills. This Science Camp is designed for students to tackle varied question types by effectively integrating relevant scientific concepts. With a strong focus on gradually challenging free response questions types like experiment-based and application questions, students will master key techniques to answer these questions with greater accuracy.

Junior Creative Writing Camp (P2/P3)

Learning Objectives:

Equip lower-primary students with planning and descriptive-writing strategies for school writing examinations and essay competitions. Students learn to craft interesting story plots and replace mundane vocabulary with creative and descriptive phrases.

Senior Creative Writing Camp (P4/P5)

Learning Objectives:

Prepares students for essay competitions and PSLE composition examination. Students will learn how to develop their own unique yet realistic storylines and use advanced writing techniques to craft out descriptive essays.

Junior Olympiad Math and Science Camp (P1/P2)

Learning Objectives:

Develops critical thinking skills to prepare children for future Olympiad math and science competitions and high ability tests. The camp focuses on problem-solving skills and includes a strong combination of both IQ Math and Science components to engage children in a holistic learning environment.

Oral English Camp - Junior (P2/P3)

Learning Objectives:

Prepares students for picture discussion and reading components based on PSLE English Oral examination format. Students will learn techniques to improve fluency and articulation of their reading and delivery of ideas.
